



Reading to your child should be a ritual. Try to do it regularly.



Look for a cozy reading place. Cuddling and reading should belong together.



Look at picture books and talk about the pictures with your child.



Sing with your child, play finger games and say rhymes.

Visit a library with your child and take part in offers such as baby book groups and picture book movies.

Choose books that appeal to the different senses: Touching books, crinkling books, books with toys, and with digital support.

Talk with your child in your mother tongue at home and daily and read books to your child in the same language.
